## LIGHTHOUSE TOUR/KENNEBUNKPORT Thursday, September 12

Begin the day with a stop at Portland Head Light, built in 1791 and authorized by President George Washington. It is the oldest lighthouse in Maine and also the most photographed. Visit the museum on park property to learn about the history and its importance to the area. Then enjoy a drive by Spring Point Ledge Light. Once in Kennebunkport, you'll have free time for lunch and shopping on your own at many possibilities. Before heading back to Portland, your tour guide will direct the bus around Kennebunkport, such a picturesque town, located along the Kennebunk River. Historically a fishing village, in recent decades the town has become a popular seaside tourist destination with a small district of souvenir shops, art galleries, seafood restaurants, and eateries. Its reputation as a superb community comes from the numerous large seaside estates along Ocean Avenue and other coastal thoroughfares. The famous "Bush Compound" is located on Walker's Point, a peninsula visible from Ocean Avenue. During the fall, Kennebunkport is known as a favorite spot for enjoying the famous New England fall colors.

## FOSTER'S CLAMBAKE Thursday, September 12

Join the Maine tradition at Foster's for an authentic New England Clambake, but first drive by Nubble Light House for a brief picture stop. Upon arrival at Foster's, enjoy social time with a drink at the cash bar and a walk around the facility to see the clambake cooking in the fresh air over the fire. Once seated for dinner, enjoy clam chowder, along with clams and lobster. The meal is rounded out with corn, potatoes, and blueberry crumb cake for dessert. For those of you that may not care for seafood, BBQ chicken or a vegetarian option can be substituted for lobster. Enjoy live music with Foster's one-man band. You may even want to sing along!
