# **TOUR DESCRIPTIONS**

# Tuesday, August 22, 2023

#### COLLEGE OF THE OZARKS

Described by the Wall Street Journal as "one of the most unusual little liberal arts colleges in the country", the College of the Ozarks was founded in 1906. Known as "C of O", it is best known for giving students the opportunity to receive a tuition-free education and debt-free graduation.

Students, with assistance of staff, designed and built the Vietnam Memorial on campus. The State of Missouri adopted it as the Missouri State Vietnam Memorial. In addition, there are 3 other veterans memorials on campus. Four of their prior graduates went on to become Generals including: 4 Star General Terrence R. Drake, USMC, Vietnam Veteran, Chopper Pilot, Pilot for 3 Presidents on Marine 1, Assistant Commandant of the USMC. Lt General Gary H. Hughey, USMC, Vietnam Veteran, Major General Jerry W. Ragsdale, USAF and Brigadier General Tommy I. Bell, USAF. He flew 243 combat missions in the F-4C fighter from November 1966 to September 1967.

Many of the additional attractions and noted locations you will see are fully staffed by dedicated C of O students, including your tour guide! Because they are students, they do ask that the tour start on time as many of them have class following the tour. The tour includes visiting the Williams Memorial Chapel, Greenhouses, Mill and the Fruitcake and Jelly Kitchen. Some of these attractions may not be available at the time of your scheduled tour. At the conclusion of your tour, feel free to stop in the Gift Shop and Bookstore. After departing the college, the group will head over to Branson Landing, a lakeside mall with mainstream stores and dining options.
